- This is due to a very good and high performance instrument, the work of the TEC, efficient ground processing and distribution,
- A tremendous amount of work has already been performed on IASI data
- Very promising mission (with 2 other models)
- But a lot of work has still to be done
- Day 2 products and new applications are a good motivation to continue
